CPC will provide the meal for the participants for six of the weeks. We will be feeding 12 adults and 10-12 children (most under age 5). Large casseroles, crock-pot of soups, green beans, bags of salad, dressings, bananas, mac and cheese, pizzas, fried chicken, etc. are ideas for meals. Also--small bottled waters are needed. The meal needs to be delivered to the preschool between 4 and 5:30 p.m. in disposable pans. They will do all the clean up.

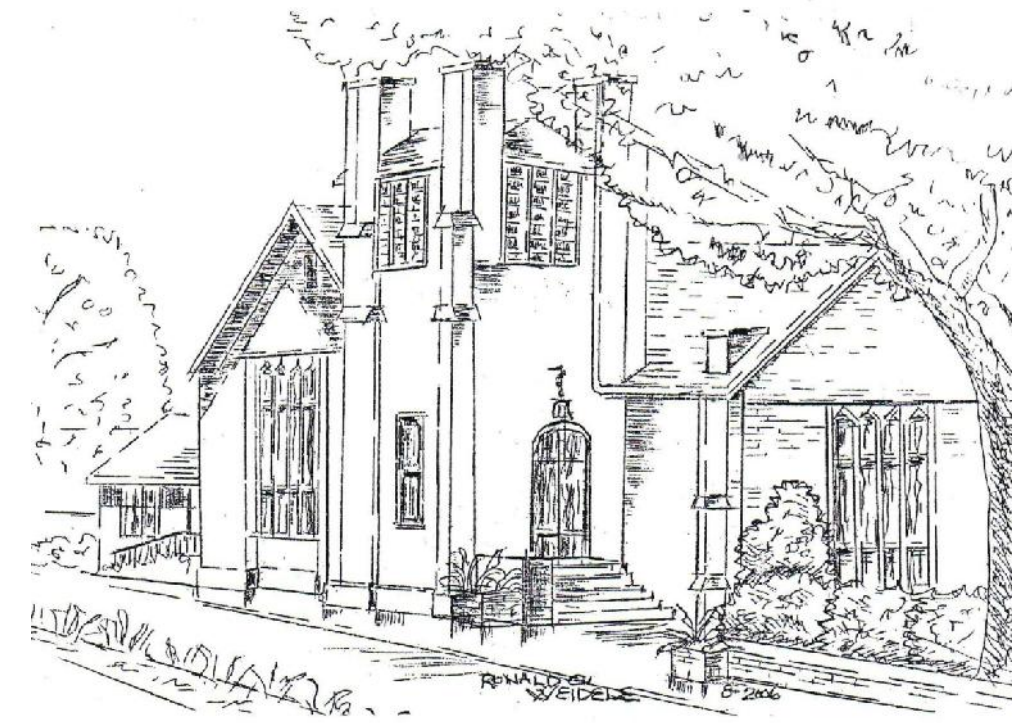
