We will be helping with the Tuesday evening **Families’ First “Celebrating Families”** educational program for families struggling because of alcohol and drug abuse. CPC will provide the meal for the participants for six of the weeks. We will be feeding 12 adults and 10-12 children (most under age 5). Large casseroles, crock-pot of soups, green beans, bags of salad, dressings, bananas, mac and cheese, pizzas, fried chicken, etc. are ideas for meals. Also--small bottled waters are needed. The meal needs to be delivered to the preschool between 4 and 5:30 p.m. in disposable pans. They will do all the clean up.

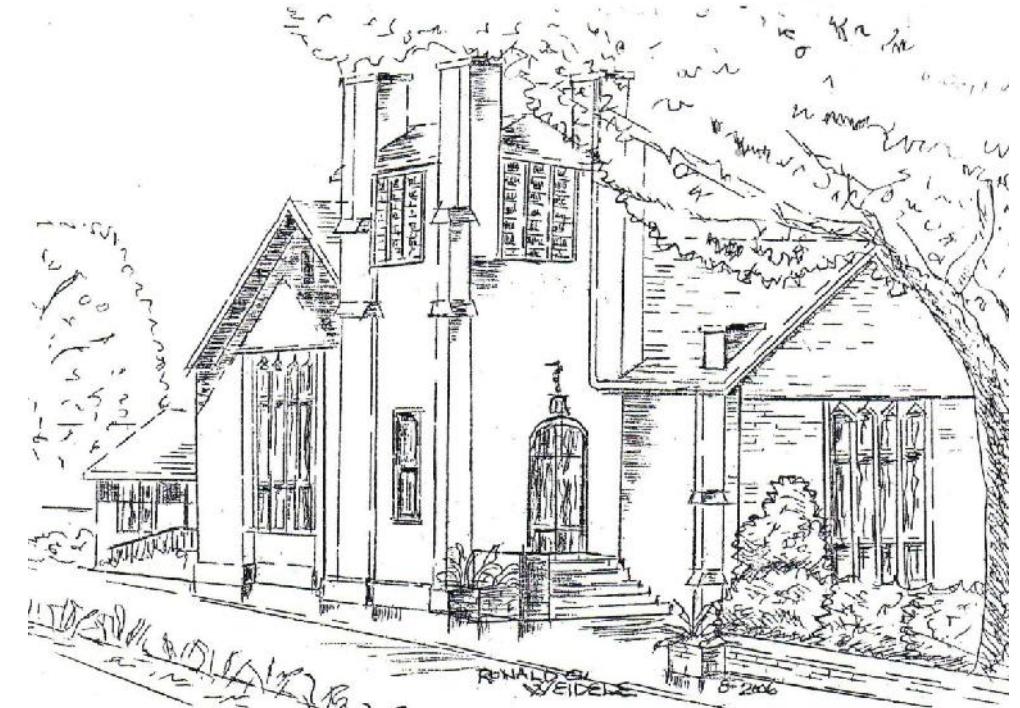
