The meal needs to be delivered to the preschool between 4 and 5:30 p.m. in disposable pans. They will do all the clean up.

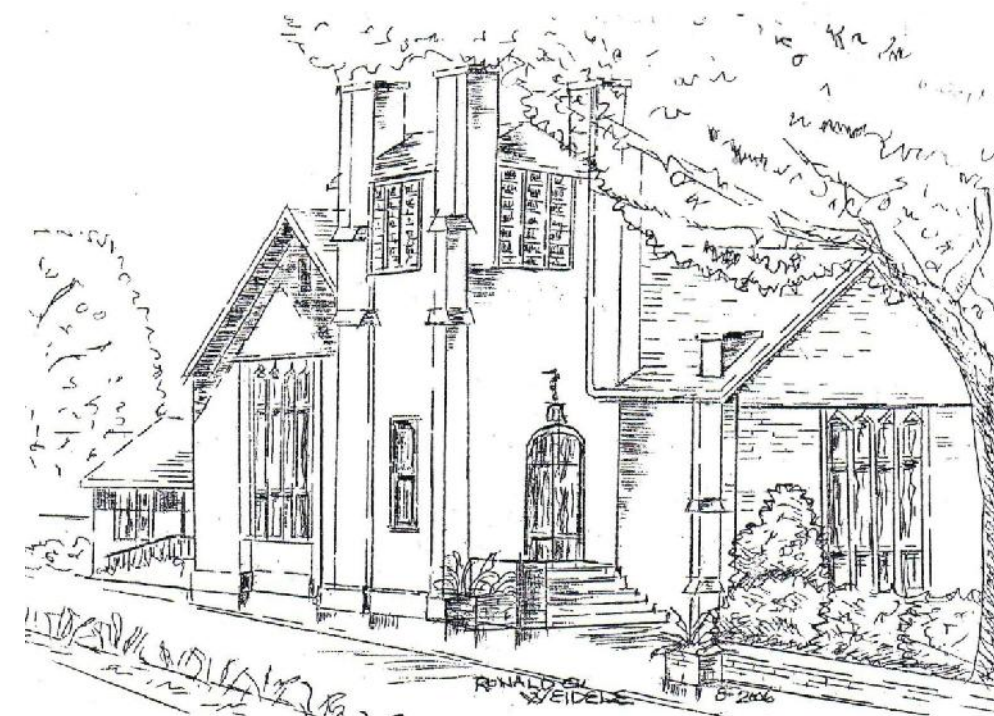
